10.1 Action Item: Approval of DE Accessibility Guidelines

For Senator convenience, the following excerpt is taken from the <u>April 26, 2022, Academic Senate meeting</u> minutes. This is intended to give Senators the history of the current item up for voting.

10.2 Action Item: DE and DPS - Strategic Accessibility Plan for Faculty (attachments from Angela)

- Discussion: Senator Osburn stated concerns regarding teaching modality and contract requirements need to be considered regarding the 40 FTEF maximum for distance education courses. Senator Osburn also stated that timelines should not be included because of the huge load this would take for adjunct faculty. Guest Angela Cardinale stated that this is already legally required and this strategic plan would help to facilitate faculty meet this requirement. Guest Angela Cardinale stated that this strategic plan is for instructors to agree that these requirements exist and that no one would be checking on them but there is no current system for instructors acknowledging the current requirements.
- Senator Chamberlain asked if accommodations for students with disabilities was the College's responsibility or the individual instructors. Guest Cardinale clarified that any material provided by the instructor needs to meet basic accessibility standards. Senator Chamberlain emphasized that there are instances where individual faculty members cannot create changes necessary that would need to be changed on the district or institution level. Guest Cardinale echoed those concerns and that the state level is also addressing these concerns under "hard to convert" courses. draft document and for changes to be made based on the discussion today and to come back with an update in the fall.
