#### What has happened so far?

- Standing Agenda Item for College Planning Council (CPC)
  - Regular reports started with the October 2021 agenda
- · Accreditation Kickoff Meeting
  - o The accreditation tri-chairs met with the standards tri-chairs on November 29, 2021.
  - Agenda highlights:
    - Reviewed tri-chair roles/responsibilities
    - Reviewed the standards
    - Evidence will drive the ISER narrative
      - Evidence and data collection that best meets the standards
      - Evidence criteria (minimum)
        - o Recent evidence
        - Best representative piece that best meets the standard
        - o Documented (minutes, publications, policies)
    - Resources shared with standards teams include
      - Accreditation timeline (see next page)
      - Visual for the work
      - Evidence analysis and evaluation workflow and sample were provided
