Resolution on Climate Change & Carbon-Neutral Campus

Whereas climate change is undeniably real and is, in fact, an emergency that continues to <u>worsen</u>,

Whereas communities of color (such as those in the Chaffey College service area) are <u>disproportionately affected</u> by climate change, pollution, and other environmental issues,

Whereas we are preparing students to be <u>ethical global citizens</u> and good stewards of the environment,

Whereas other local community colleges (such as <u>Citrus</u>, <u>Los Angeles CCD</u>, <u>Riverside</u>, <u>San Bernardino Valley</u>, and <u>Santa Monica</u>) have made strong commitments to address the climate emergency and improve sustainability,

Whereas the CCC Board of Governors adopted a <u>Climate Change and Sustainability</u> Resolution & Climate Change and Sustainability Policy in January 2020,

The Chaffey College Academic Senate hereby resolves to

Encourage faculty to include lessons and assignments on climate change, sustainability, environmental ethics, climate justice, and related issues into their courses whenever possible or relevant, across disciplines, departments, and academic / career communities,

Encourage departments to include climate-related courses in their sample degree pathways for students,

Urge the district to commit to making Chaffey College carbon neutral by 2035.
