



PART-TIME FACULTY POOL, RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY

I. **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Chaffey College has a need for a pool of part-time instructors to teach Radiologic Technology. All applicants are expected to meet the California State Community College Minimum Qualifications for Radiologic Technology instructors. Meeting the minimum qualifications does not guarantee employment or an interview.

II. <u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution and two (2) years of related experience; OR
- Associate's degree from an accredited institution and six (6) years of related experience; AND
- Clear evidence of sensitivity to and an understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability, gender identity, sexual orientation, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students.

ADDITIONAL LOCAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Four (4) years of full-time experience in the professional discipline at an acute care hospital with an emergency room;
- One (1) year of successful experience as an instructor in a JRCERT accredited program or equivalent experience;
- Hold current licensure as an American Registered Radiological Technologist (ARRT);
- Hold current certification in the State of California in diagnostic and fluoroscopic radiography CRT;
- Hold a current CPR card.

III. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Must complete a negative drug screen 10 panel plus ethanol screening result.

IV. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications are accepted on a continuous basis until the opportunity is filled or until otherwise indicated on the CCC Registry listing. In order to be considered for a part-time teaching opportunity at Chaffey College, you must submit all of the following documents through the CCC Registry website www.cccregistry.org:

- 1. CCC Registry online application
- 2. Resume/curriculum vitae
- 3. Unofficial transcripts are required immediately upon consideration for a teaching assignment, and official transcripts are required within 30 days of employment.

Once your application and resume are submitted through CCC Registry's website, your information will be available for review by the District's designated personnel for potential part-time teaching opportunities within the discipline. If you are identified as a potential candidate for an open course, you may be contacted by a District representative.

IV. COMPENSATION

Part-time faculty compensation is commensurate with education and District teaching experience according to the lecture, lab, or non-instructional rate schedules.
