8. Discussion/Information/Action Items:

8.1. Curriculum Committee Transfer Course Policy Review: The AO presented the policy changes, which specify that CSU and UC are the primary considerations for transfer courses, rather than private institutions, due to the varying checks and balances at each private institution. The committee approved the changes with a vote of 13/0/0.

8.2. Final Revisions to Title 5, California Code of Regulations Relating to Course Outline of Record:

Curriculum committees shall have a documented procedure to guarantee accessibility for every student to ensure individuals with disabilities can equally participate in learning through course outlines of record that reflect universal design for learning strategies, which include multiple means of representation, engagement, and expression to support learner variability and diversity.

The Specialist shared a presentation on <u>Universal Design for Learning (UDL) in Course Outlines of Record</u>. She shared how faculty and the Curriculum Committee have already integrated UDL into Chaffey CORs through the existing DEIA opportunities. This integration can be seen in course content, class assignments, and methods of instruction and evaluation. To further strengthen this work and make it more visible, she suggested:

- Add a short UDL information note (with a resource, similar to the slides) next to each DEIA opportunity in META.
- Include the UDL method within the header of each section of the COR.
- Embed DEIA opportunities under the appropriate COR headers, since DEIA will need to be explicitly included with the 9th edition of the PCAH

The committee had a few minor formatting suggestions and was supportive of the proposed changes.
