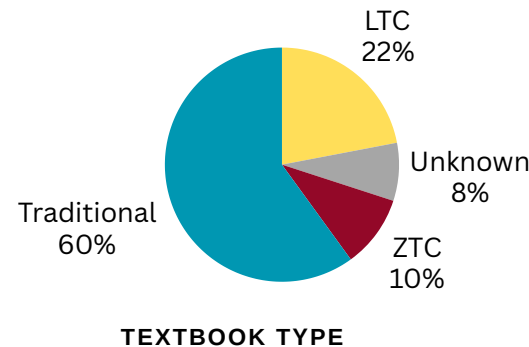
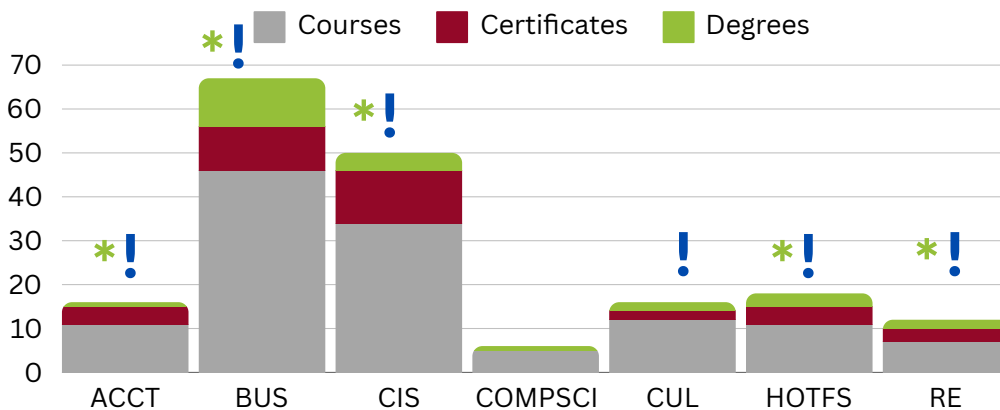


NUMBER OF AWARD EARNERS
