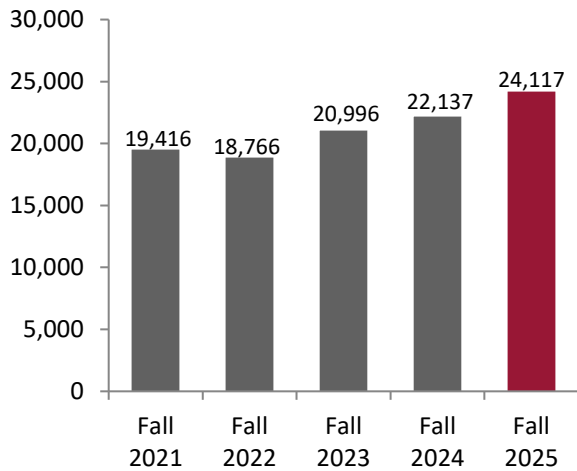

Covering credit enrollments as of first census (September 2, 2025)

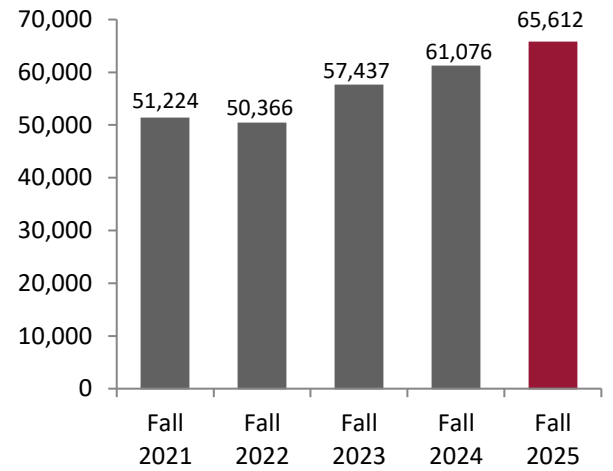
### Unduplicated Student Headcount



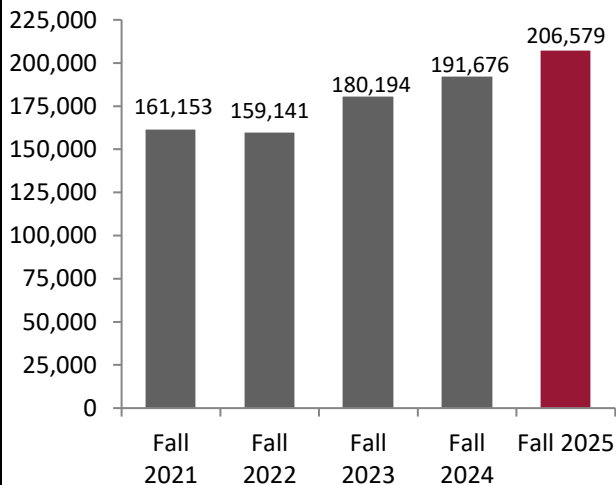
← 1,980 more credit students than last fall (+8.9%).

### Number of Credit Enrollments



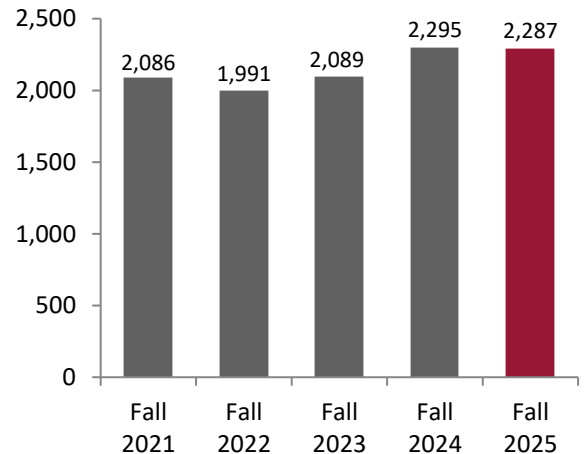
### Total Credit Units Attempted



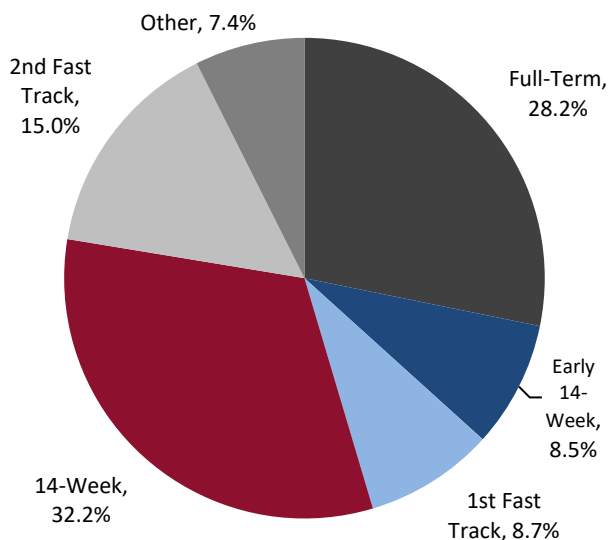
← 14,903 more units attempted by students than last fall (+7.8%).

### Number of Credit Sections Offered

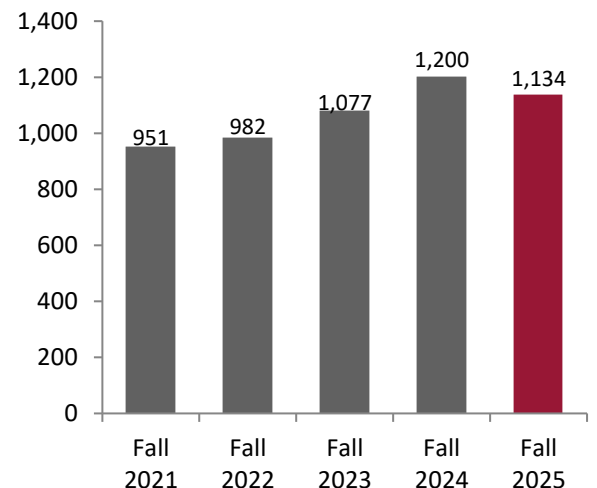


### Section Distribution by Session Length

### Number of Late Start Sections

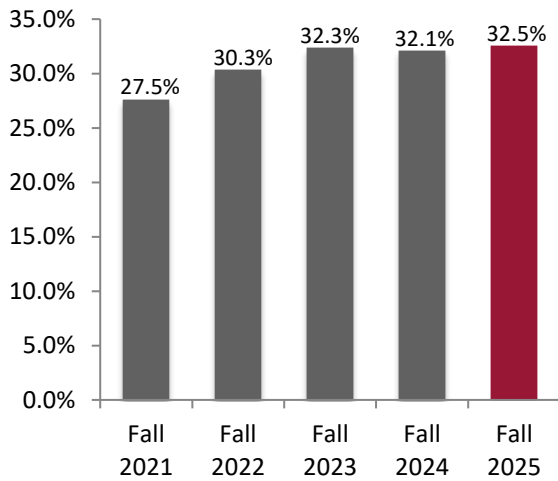

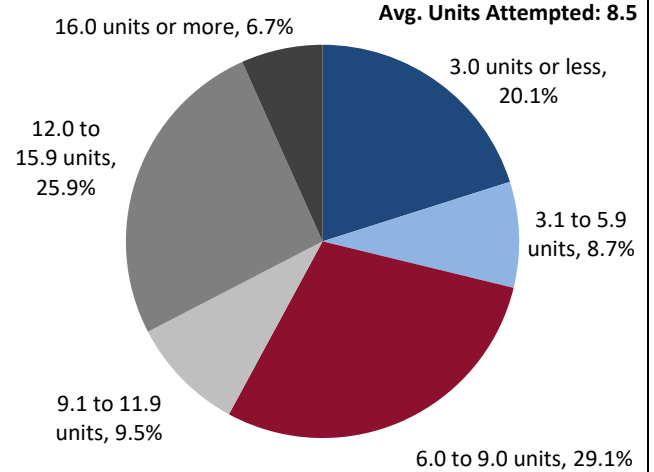
### Full-Time Student Enrollment Comparison



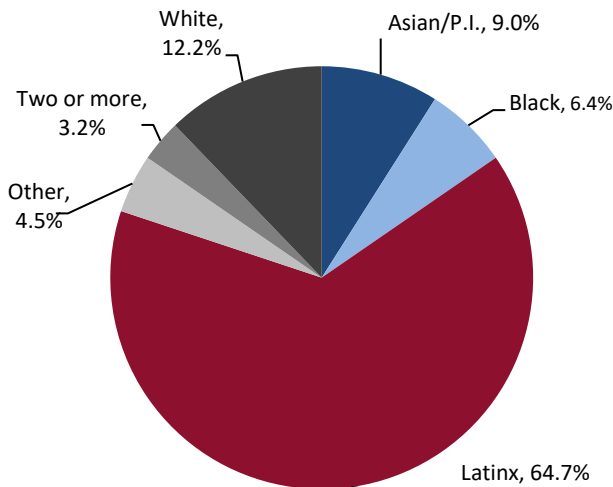
← The distribution of full-time students has remained relatively constant the last three fall terms.

### Units Attempted Ranges



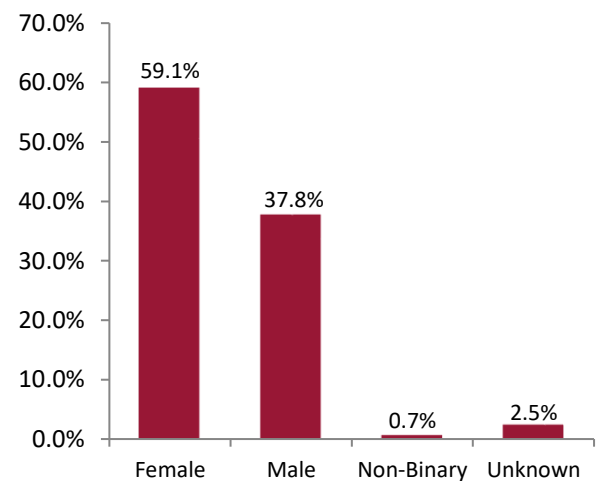
### Student Ethnicity



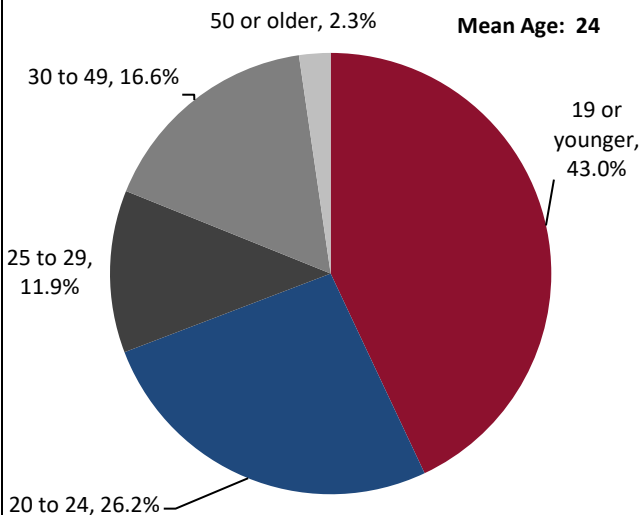
← 83.3% of students are from historically under-represented student populations, (last fall: 83.4%).
