

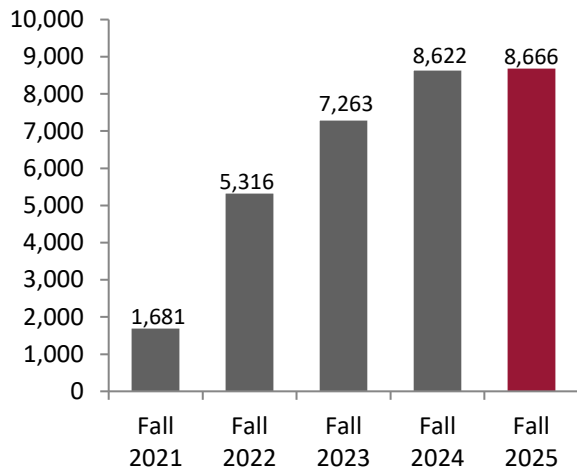

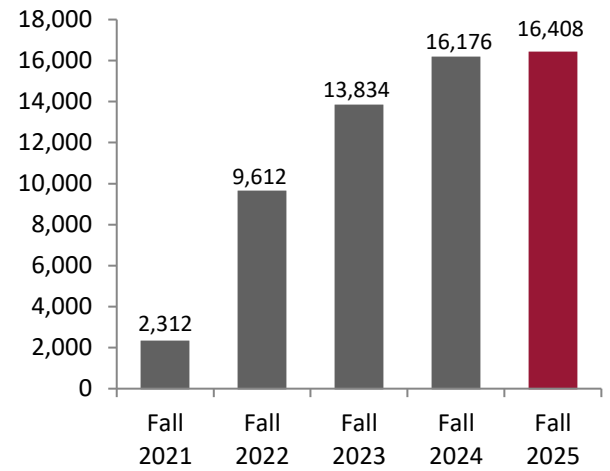
Unduplicated Student Headcount



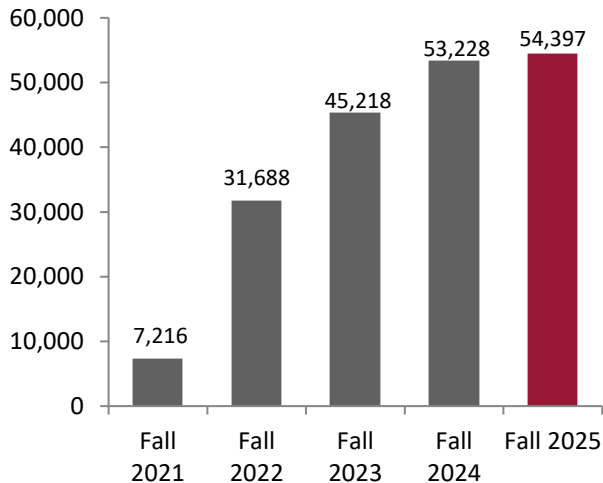
← 44 more credit students than last fall (+0.5%).

Number of Credit Enrollments



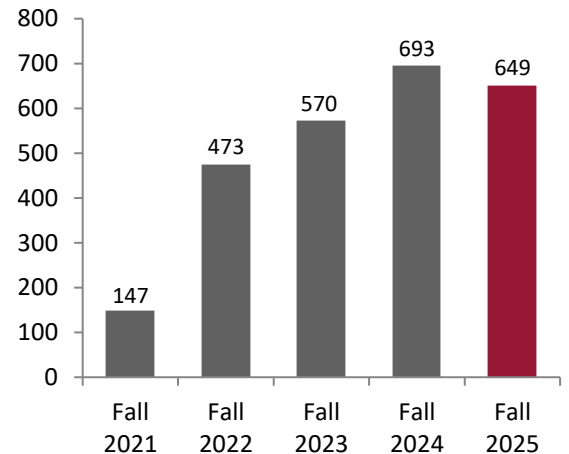
Total Credit Units Attempted



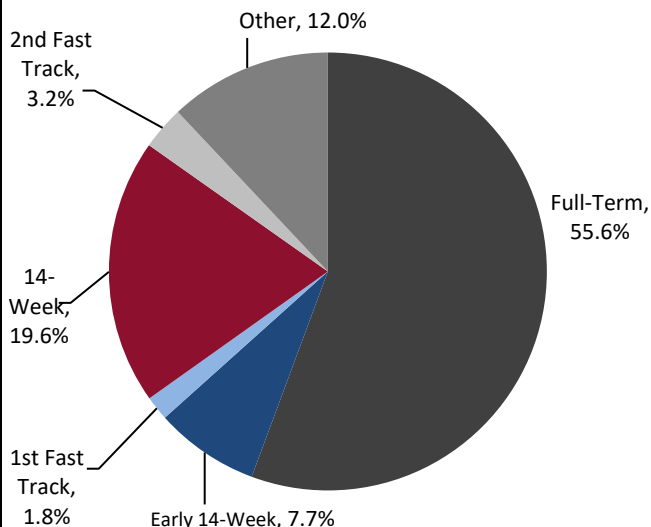
← 1169 more units attempted by students than last fall (+2.2%).

Number of Credit Sections Offered

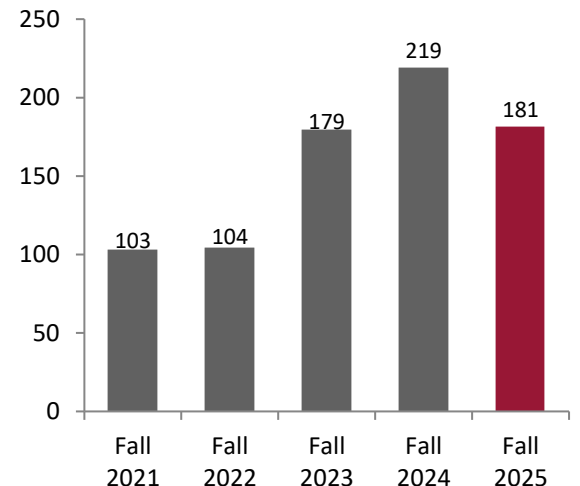


Section Distribution by Session Length

Number of Late Start Sections



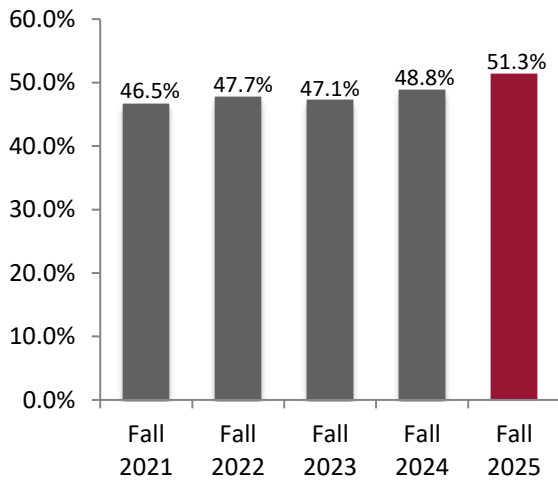

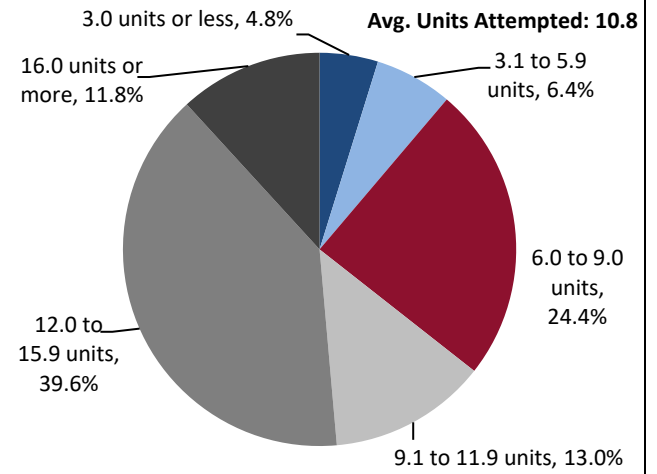
Full-Time Student Enrollment Comparison



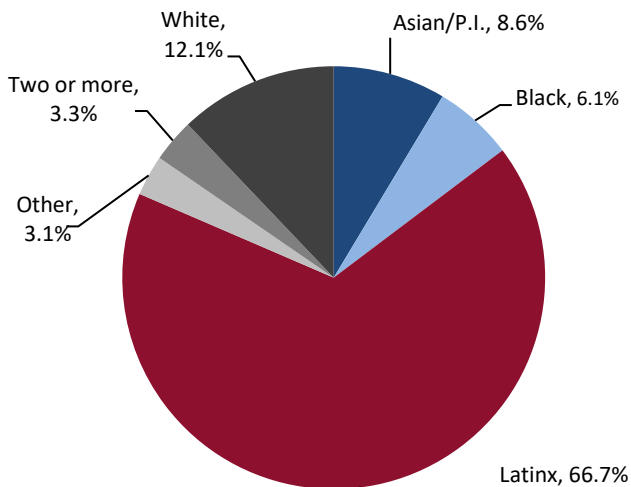
← The distribution of full-time students has increased by 2.5% from last fall term.

Units Attempted Ranges



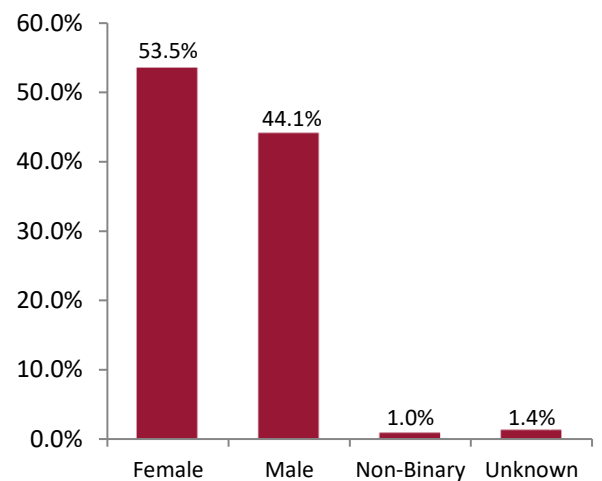
Student Ethnicity



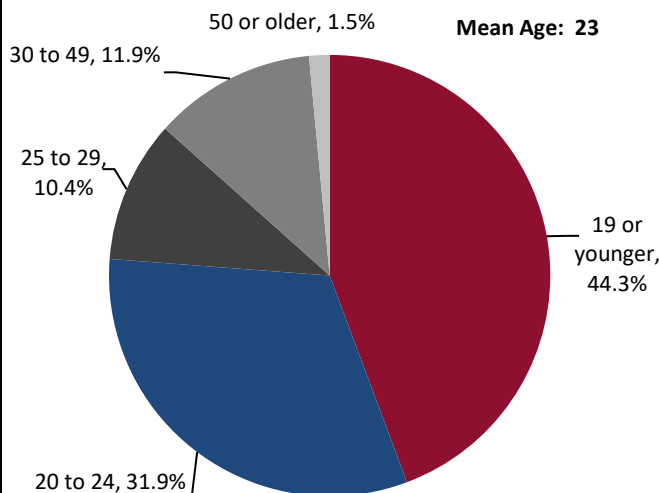
← 84.7% of students are from historically under-represented student populations.
