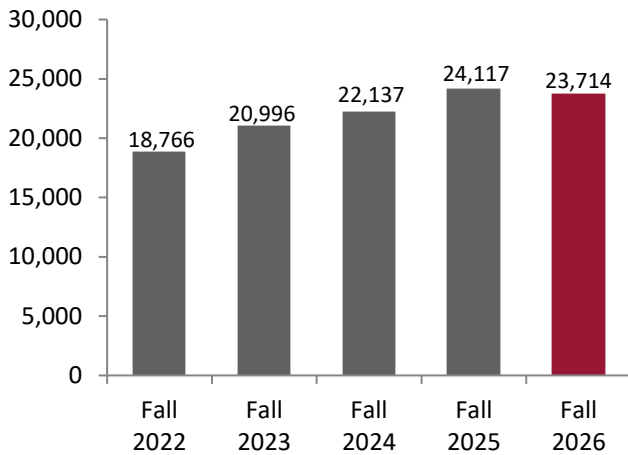

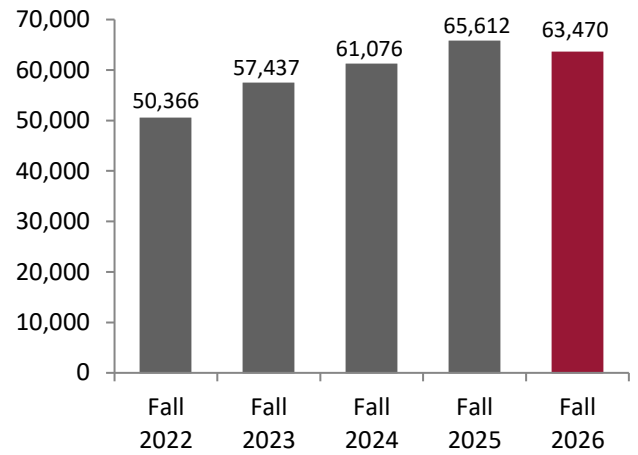

Unduplicated Student Headcount

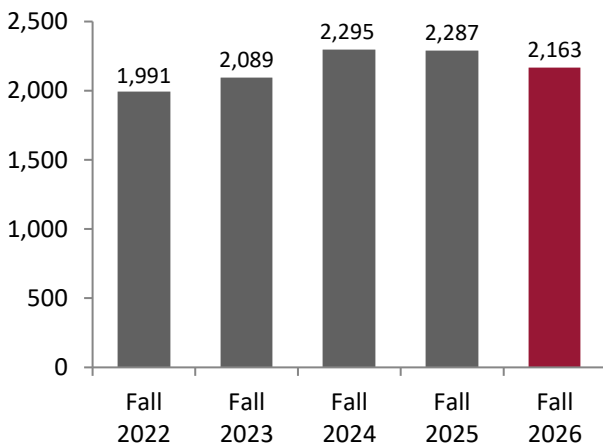


While both figures reflect a modest dip from last fall's record high, the district has increased headcount and enrollments by over 25% since Fall 2022.

Number of Credit Enrollments

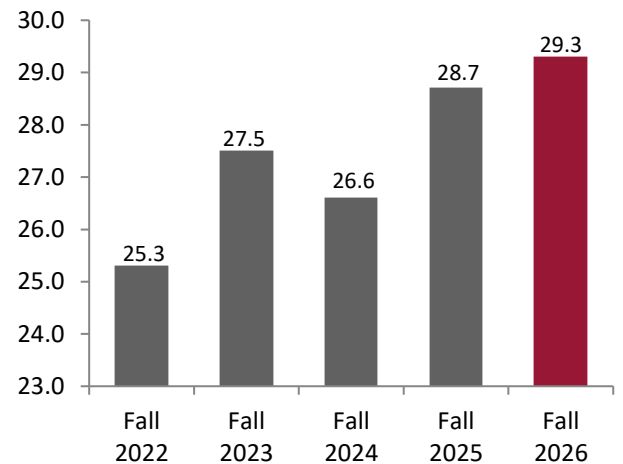


Number of Credit Sections Offered

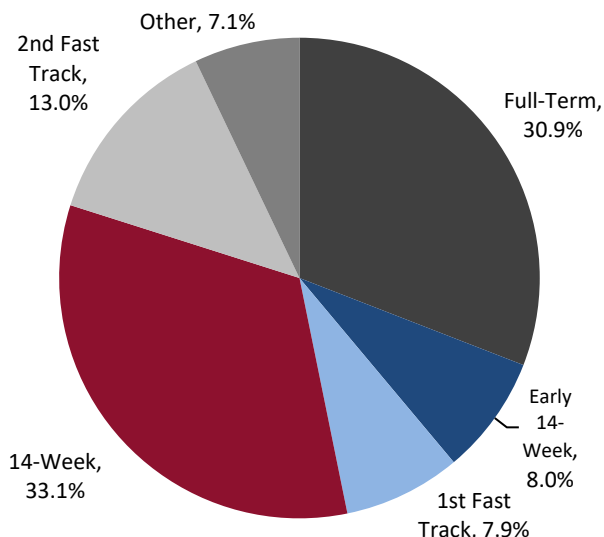


While the number of section offerings is slightly down from last fall, the average class size has climbed to a 5-year high of 29.3 students per section.

Average Number of Students Per Section



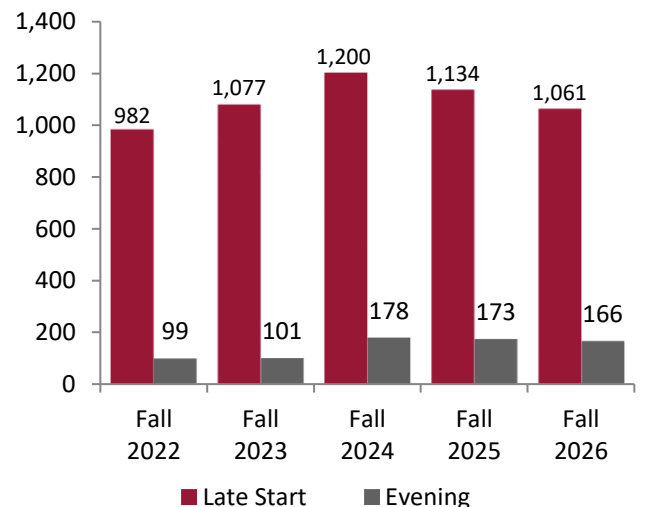
Section Distribution by Session Length



The percentage of full-term section offerings is up for a second year in a row (+2.7%).

Despite modest year-over-year declines, late-start and evening sections grew 8% and 68% respectively since Fall 2022, highlighting the district's commitment to flexible scheduling.

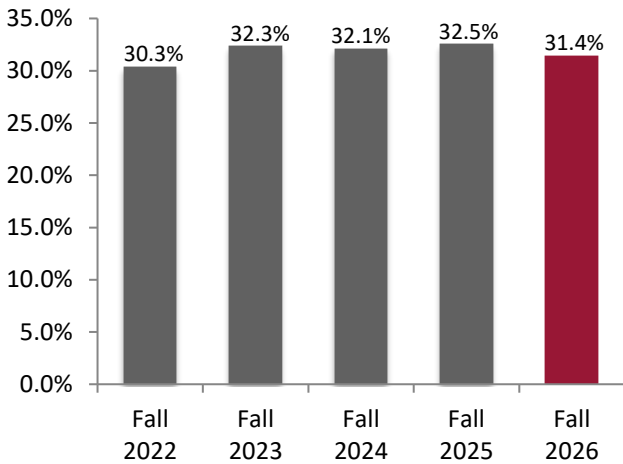
Number of Late Start and Evening Sections

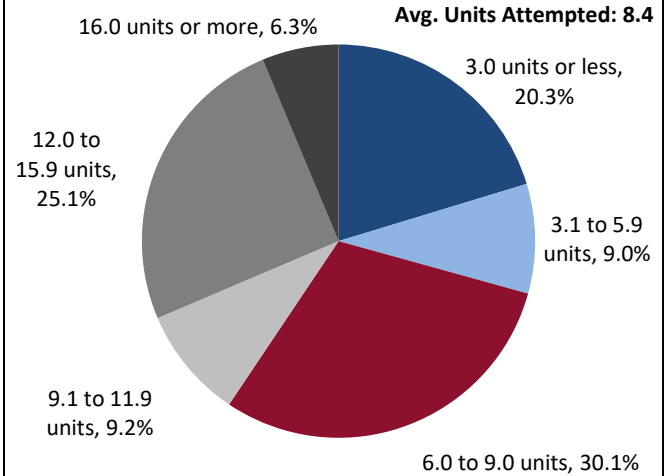
Full-Time Student Enrollment Comparison



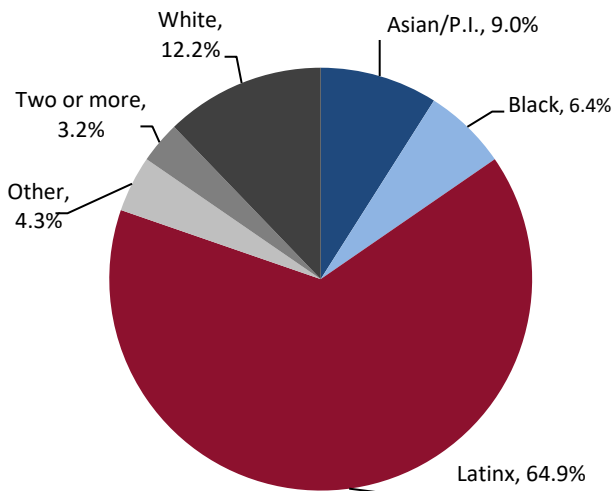
← Full-time enrollment dipped slightly but remains fairly stable, with nearly one in three students carrying a full-time course load.

Students are actively enrolled in an average of 8.4 units, which is similar to last fall (8.5).

Units Attempted Ranges



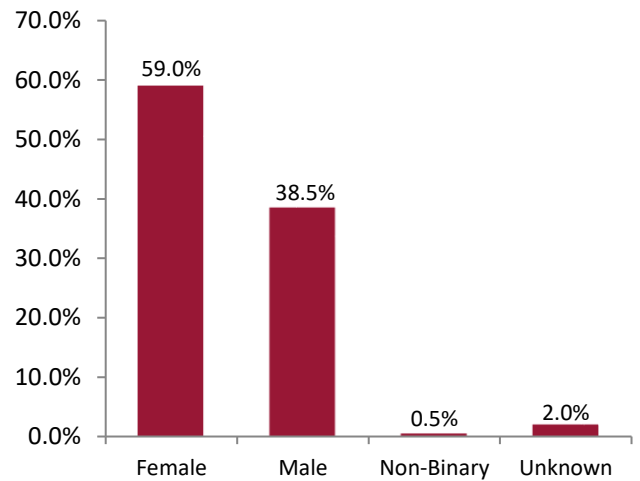
Student Ethnicity



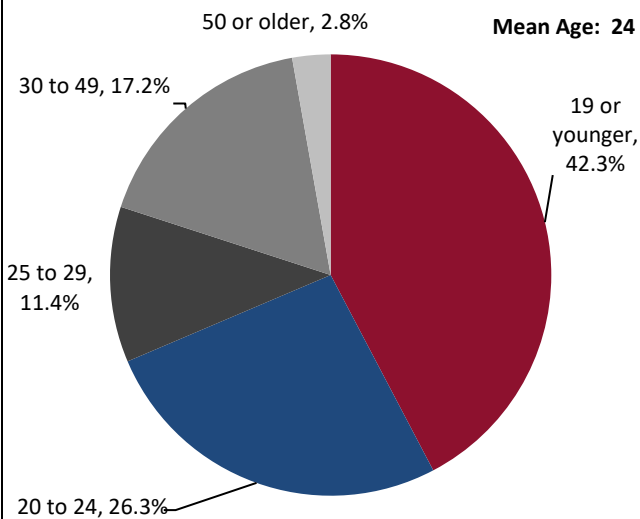
← 83.5% of students are from historically under-represented student populations (last fall: 83.3%).

The district's student body remains predominantly female (59.0%), with male enrollment ticking up slightly (+0.7 percentage points) from last fall.
