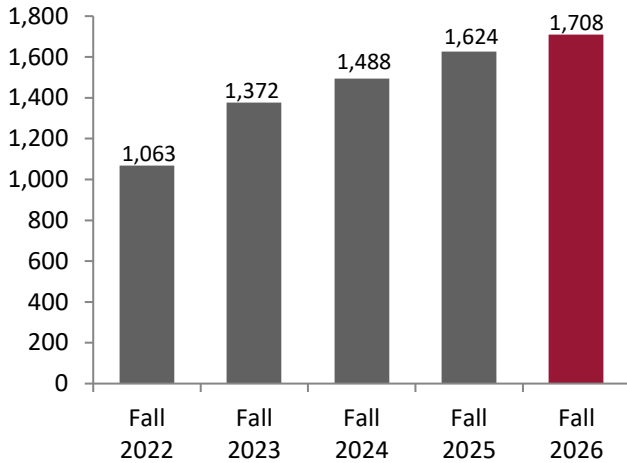

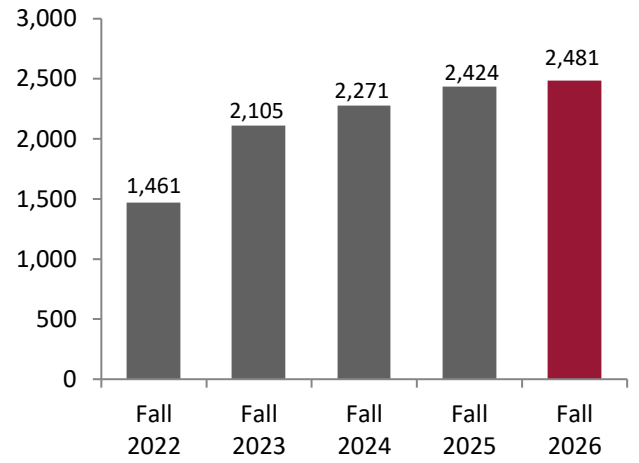

Unduplicated Student Headcount

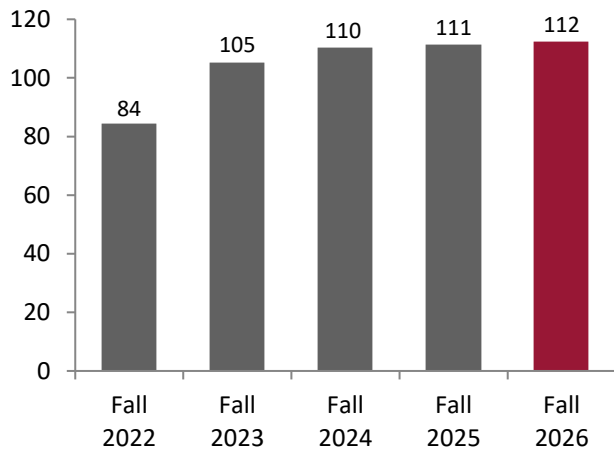


Headcount and enrollment continue to grow at the Chino campus, both reaching a five-year high and growing over 60% since Fall 2022.

Number of Credit Enrollments

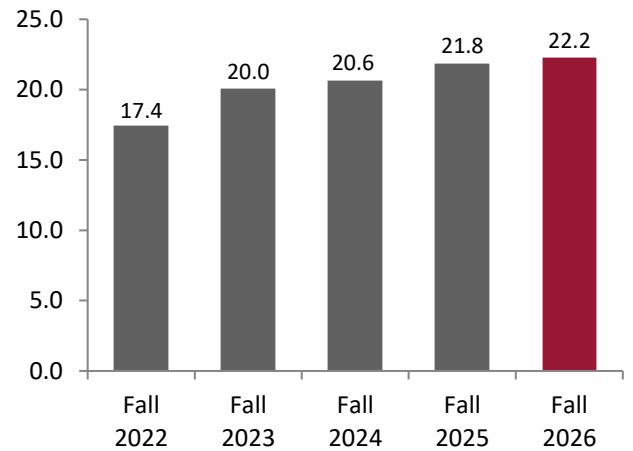


Number of Credit Sections Offered

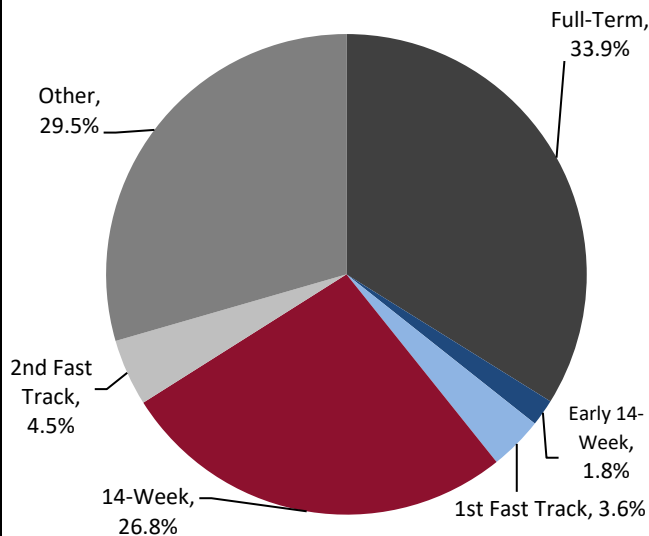


Both the number of section offerings and the average class size continued to rise this fall, with class size reaching 22.2 students per section.

Average Number of Students Per Section



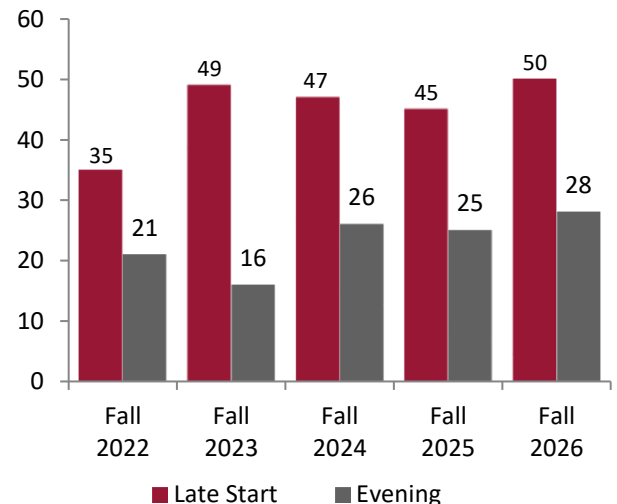
Section Distribution by Session Length



While full-term credit offerings fell from last fall's rate (41.4%), the percentage of short-term offerings rose by 11.5%.

Number of Late Start and Evening Sections



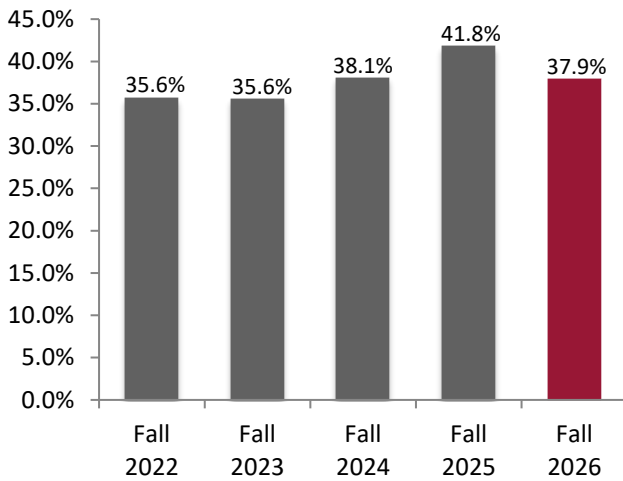

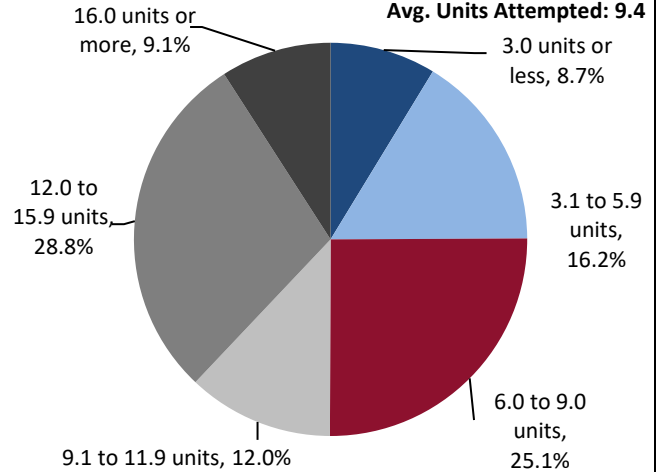
Full-Time Student Enrollment Comparison



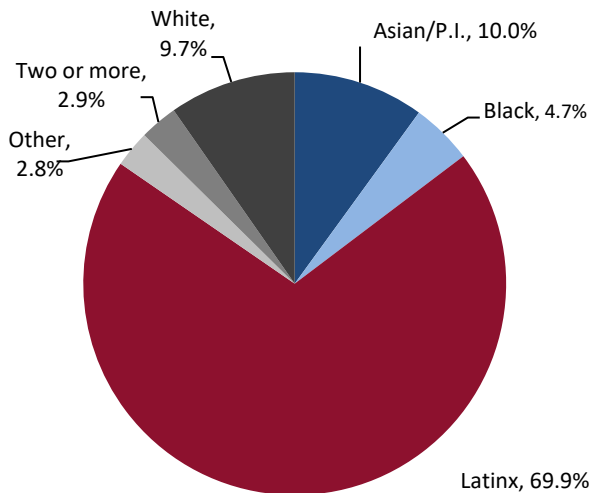
← The distribution of full-time students has decreased by 3.9% from last fall term.

Units Attempted Ranges



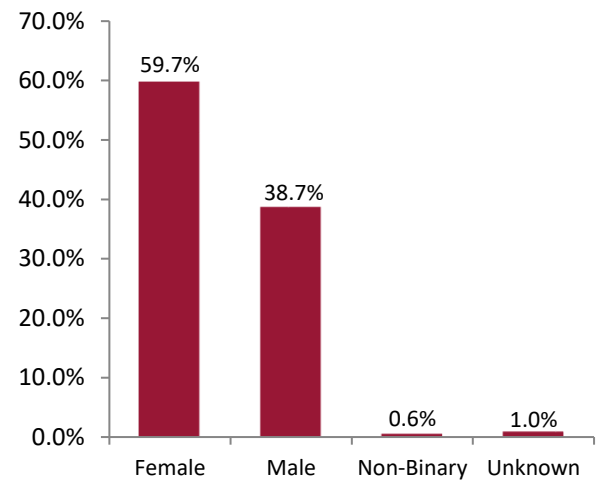
Student Ethnicity



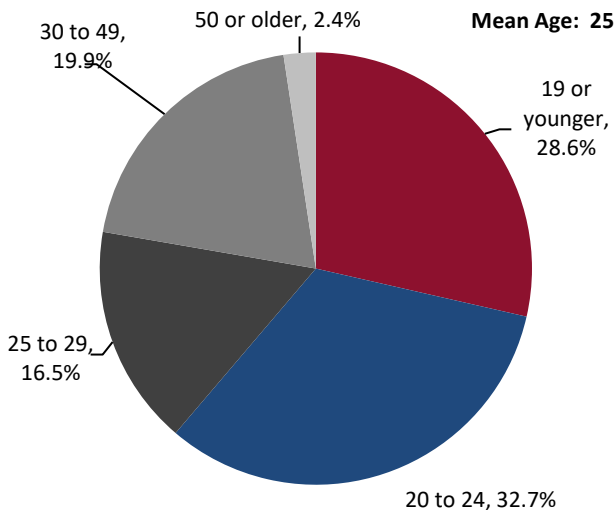
← 87.5% of students are from historically under-represented student populations.
