




Chaffey District – Spring 2026 Semester Covering credit enrollments as of first census (February 2, 2026)





← 994 more credit students than last spring (+4.5%). Headcounts are up 39% over five years.

986 more credit enrollments than last spring (+1.7%). →




← 3,745 more units attempted by students than last spring (+2.0%).


191 less sections offered than last spring (-8.5%). →



← This spring the district offered 159 less late start sections (-14.4%). 14-week and both fast-track sessions saw decreases compared to last spring.



→ The district offered 12 less evening sections this spring (-6.6%). Evening class offerings are up 121% over five years.







← The percentage of full-time students has decreased for the first time in the last five years (-1.7%).

→ Students are enrolled in an average of 8.2 units, which is slightly less than last spring (8.4).



← 82.9% of students are from historically under-represented student populations, (last spring: 82.6%).

→ The percentage of male students has slightly increased from last spring (+0.4%).



← Mean student age is the same as last spring (24). The percentage of 19 or younger students has increased by 4.4% from last spring.

→ 31.5% of all students reside outside of the Chaffey District boundaries.
