




## Chino Campus – Spring 2026 Semester

Covering credit enrollments as of first census (February 2, 2026)


### Unduplicated Student Headcount




← 195 more credit students than last spring (+14.5%).

### Number of Credit Enrollments




### Total Credit Units Attempted




← 761 more units attempted by students than last spring (+12.2%).

### Number of Credit Sections Offered




### Section Distribution by Session Length




← → This spring the Chino campus offered 2 less late start sections (-5.0%). No early 14-week classes were offered.

→ The Chino campus offered 2 less evening sections this spring (-6.7%).



### Number of Late Start and Evening Sections







← The distribution of full-time students remained nearly the same compared to last spring.

Students are enrolled in an average of 9.7 units.



← 88.4% of students are from historically under-represented student populations. 5.6% more than the district.

→ The reported gender distribution of students is closely similar to the district.



← The mean student age is two years higher than the district.

→ 34.9% of all students reside outside of the Chaffey District boundaries.
