

Covering credit enrollments as of first census (February 2, 2026)


Unduplicated Student Headcount




← 89 more credit students than last spring (+10.9%).

Number of Credit Enrollments




Total Credit Units Attempted




← 322 more units attempted by students than last spring (+9.1%).

Number of Credit Sections Offered




Section Distribution by Session Length



→ The Fontana campus offered 3 less evening sections this spring (-23.1%).



Number of Late Start and Evening Sections







← The distribution of full-time students decreased by 0.4%.

→ Students are enrolled in an average of 9.9 units.



← 89.7% of students are from historically under-represented student populations. 6.8% more than the district.

→ The Fontana campus has a higher percentage of male students compared to the district (+4.6%).



← The mean student age is one year lower than the district.

→ 36% of all students reside outside of the Chaffey District boundaries.
