

Covering credit enrollments as of first census (February 2, 2026)


Unduplicated Student Headcount




← 242 more credit students than last spring (+3.1%).

Number of Credit Enrollments




Total Credit Units Attempted




← 870 more units attempted by students than last spring (+1.8%).

Number of Credit Sections Offered




Section Distribution by Session Length




← This spring the Rancho Cucamonga campus offered 25 less late start sections (-13.3%).

→ The Rancho Cucamonga campus offered 3 more evening classes this spring (-3.1%). Evening class offerings are up 206% over five years.



Number of Late Start and Evening Sections







← The distribution of full-time students slightly decreased (-1.2%).

Students are enrolled in an average of 10.6 units.



← 84.4% of students are from historically under-represented student populations. 1.5% more than the district.

→ The Rancho Cucamonga campus has a higher percentage of male students compared to the district (+6.1%).



← The mean student age is one year lower than the district.

→ 28.5% of students reside outside of the Chaffey District boundaries.
