



Award Attainment (Grad Exit) Survey Result 2024 - 2025

On April 18, 2025 the award attainment survey was distributed to 2,800 students that received awards in Summer 2024 or Fall 2024, or had a pending graduation application for Spring 2025. To boost the response rate of the survey, five Grad Bags (valued at \$149.99) were offered to students that responded within two weeks. This year marks the first time this version of the survey was administered. Each question was revised from previous years. The survey was started by 726 students and had a completion rate of 79% (577), or 21% of the total audience.

Executive Summary

Learning Environment

- Ten of the eleven satisfaction statements regarding the learning environment had a median score of 5, indicating the majority of students are very satisfied.
- "Opportunities for you to collaborate with your classmates" was the only statement with a median score of 4, indicating that most students are, at the least, satisfied.

Student Services

- The majority of students stated that it was "easy" to "very easy" to access all services at Chaffey College when needed.
- Regarding ease of access, student employment, counseling services, and career services had the lowest average scores.
- The Campus Store, library services, and Success Centers ranked the highest in access.
- The majority of students agree that counseling services and financial aid greatly contribute to their overall success. Registration services were also ranked highly.
- Many of the write-in responses highlighted the need for more counselors and easier access to counseling services and appointment scheduling.

Staying on Track

- The majority of students either agree or strongly agree with all statements about progress (course requirements, career opportunities, transfer requirements, and educational plan). However, awareness of career opportunities related to student's programs of study received 20.3% neutral responses, and the lowest average score of the four statements.
- 59% stated that they always followed their ed plan, with another 29% indicating they often followed their ed plan (88% combined). Only 3% indicated that they didn't have an ed plan. 13% indicated that they didn't have enough support to understand/follow their ed plan.
- The greatest challenge faced by students is balancing work and school responsibilities (64%), followed by financial challenges (39%). 61% stated the college's support services were effective in addressing challenges.
- Some write-in responses indicated difficulty with ed plans, such as not knowing about some course requirements or dealing with limited section availability and class cancellations, which prolonged their completion.

Engagement and Sense of Belonging

- The majority of students either agree or strongly agree with all statements about engagement and sense of belonging. Feeling connected to the Chaffey College community and having access to culturally relevant support services received more neutral responses than the other statements.
- 85% agreed the college promotes an inclusive environment.
- 87% felt welcomed; 70% felt connected to the college community.

Overall Experience

- 79% fully accomplished their goals at Chaffey.
- 77% said Chaffey was their first choice; 93% would choose it again.
- 92% were satisfied or very satisfied with their overall experience.

Academic, Community and Employability Skills (ACES)

- All ACES areas received strong ratings, with average scores ranging from 4.1 to 4.3 and median scores of 4 ('Quite a bit') or 5 ('Very much'), reflecting well-rounded development across all skills.
- Most students strongly agreed that their experience at Chaffey College contributed meaningfully to their development in critical thinking, communication, resilience, and professionalism.

Future Plans


- 71% plan to transfer to a 4-year institution; 51% plan to obtain a job related to their major.
- 87% feel well or very well prepared for their next steps.


Question 1 (Alternative View) - Please rate your overall satisfaction or dissatisfaction with the following aspects of the learning environment at Chaffey College?


Question 2 (Alternative View) - How easy was it for you to access the following services at Chaffey College when needed?








Question 5 - To what extent did you follow the educational plan you created with an academic counselor during your time at Chaffey College?




Question 6 - Did you have enough support to understand and follow your educational plan?

Question 7 - During your time at the college, did you experience any of the following challenges or barriers to completion? (Select all that apply)





Question 8 - If you faced challenges, how effective were the college's support services in helping you address them?










Question 12 - Was Chaffey College your first choice of colleges?

Question 13 - If you were to begin your college career again, would you still choose Chaffey College?




Question 14 (Write-In Responses Summary) - Please explain why you would not choose to attend Chaffey College again?

Question 15 - How satisfied are you with your overall experience at Chaffey College?









Some write in responses included the following improvement themes:

Improve Counseling Accessibility and Quality:

- Increase the number of available counselors (8 mentions).
- Make it easier to schedule appointments and reduce wait times (8 mentions).
- Improve the consistency of advice from counselors, ensuring they provide correct and helpful information (2 mentions).
- Ensure counselors clarify post-graduation plans, especially transfer requirements and prerequisites (2 mentions).

Strengthen Transfer Support:

- Provide more information about transferring to four-year colleges, including deadlines, at least a year prior to graduation (3 mentions).
- Improve the helpfulness and overall effectiveness of the Transfer Center (3 mentions).
- Improve the frequency and timing of transfer workshops, fairs, and events (2 mentions).

Increase Course Availability and Flexibility:

- Offer more sections for waitlisted classes (3 mentions).
- Increase the availability of in-person classes, with some mentions of evening and Saturday options for working students (3 mentions).

• Increase Awareness and Promotion of Resources and Events:

- Better advertise activities and resources offered by the Library (2 mentions).
- Make student services more known to students, especially for first-year students and transfer applicants (3 mentions).
- Increase awareness of support and club events to encourage on-campus involvement and community building (2 mentions).

Enhance Student Engagement and Community Building:

• Have more students involved on campus and create more ways for students to connect (2 mentions).
