Student Basic Need Insecurities (BNI) - 2025


Overview: In the fall 2024 semester Chaffey College participated in the 2025 Real College California Survey, a statewide survey conducted by the Research & Planning (RP) Group on behalf of the Community College League of California (CCLC) Real College California Coalition. The survey was disseminated to all students who were actively enrolled in the fall 2024 semester. Chaffey College received 2,075 responses. The number of responses recorded affords the college the opportunity to generalize findings to the entire fall 2024 student population (23,095 students) with a 99% confidence level and margin of error of approximately 2.5%. 
Type of BNI Experienced

Food Insecurity assessed over the past month; all other insecurities assessed over the past year




Experiences with Food Insecurity

Housing insecurity increased from 2023 to 2025




Knowledge/Access to BN Centers
