## Statewide College Decisions Survey - Chaffey College Results

Overview: In partnership with the California Community College Chancellor's Office and the Research and Planning (RP) Group, Chaffey College participated in a statewide survey earlier this fall to gain a better understanding of factors affecting continuing and prospective students' decisions to attend Chaffey College.



820 individuals responded to the survey:

- 390 prospective students (47.5%)
- 430 continuing students (52.5%)

### Top Factors Affecting Students' Decisions Not to Enroll at Chaffey College

**Prospective Students** - Individuals who had applied but were not enrolled at the time of the survey

Factor	% of Respondents
Considering another college/university	39.4%
Cannot afford college at this time	26.8%
Delaying college plans	21.1%
I have to prioritize work	18.3%
I have dependents who I need to care for	14.1%

**Continuing Students** - Students who previously enrolled at Chaffey College but were not enrolled at the time of the survey

Factor	% of Respondents
Cannot afford college at this time	37.2%
I have to prioritize work	36.3%
I have dependents I need to care for	29.2%
Need to prioritize mental health	25.7%
Do not have a place to study and focus on homework	24.8%

### What Else Did Continuing Students Tell Us?

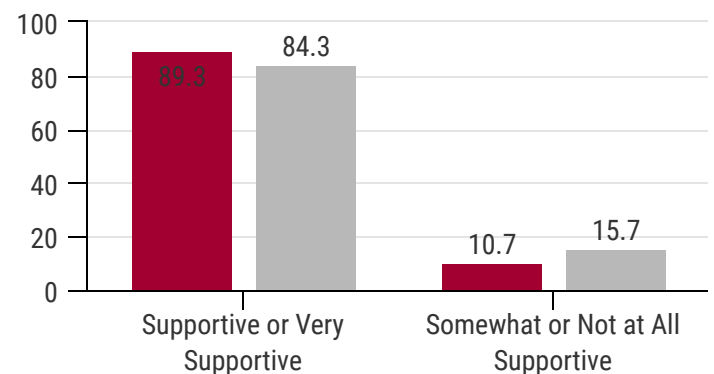


26% withdrew from one or more courses in the last semester they were enrolled at Chaffey College

Most frequently cited reasons for withdrawing from courses

Reason	% of Respondents
Had to prioritize work	33.9%
Could not keep up with pace of class(es)	32.2%
Had to prioritize mental health	26.1%
Could not afford to pay for course materials	21.7%
Could not learn in an online environment	19.1%
