Chapter 4, Instruction

AP 4228 Course Repetition – Significant Lapse of Time

Students may be permitted to repeat courses in which a "C" or better grade was earned when the following conditions apply:

- The District has established a recency prerequisite for the course, or an institution of higher education to which the student seeks to transfer has established a recency requirement that applies to that course.
- Minimum recency has elapsed since the student was awarded a grade in the course. The minimum recency may not be less than 36 months.

All enrollments, including the additional enrollment allowed as a result of the significant lapse of time, in an active participatory course in physical education, visual arts, or performing arts (families) counts toward the total enrollments.

When a course is repeated due to a significant lapse of time, the District will disregard the previous grade and credit earned when computing a student's grade point average.
