

BP 4100 Graduation Requirements for Degrees and Certificates

The District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science and Associate Degrees for Transfer to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in subjects attempted. Students must also complete the general education residency and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Achievement upon successful completion of courses of study or curriculum for which the District offers a certificate. The District has certificate programs that upgrade and develop occupational and vocational proficiency.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements that include appropriate involvement of the local curriculum committee and to assure that graduation requirements are published in the District's catalog and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
