



BP 5150 Extended Opportunities Programs and Services

Support services and programs that are in addition to the traditional student services programs shall be provided in order to assist students who have language, social, and economic disadvantages to succeed academically in the District.

The EOPS Program is established to provide services that may include, but are not limited to, outreach, recruitment, orientation, assessment, tutorial services, counseling and advising, and financial aid.

The Superintendent/President shall assure that the Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) Program conforms to all requirements established by the relevant law and regulations.
