- **d. Bill #3.2024.16 Bylaw Amendment Club Funding Revisions:** This bylaw will update the guidelines for club funding.
- e. Bill #3.2024.17 Bylaw Amendment Finance Outreach & Engagement Opportunities: This bill introduces more opportunities for engagement and outreach for those within the Finance committee bylaws.
- f. Bill #3.2024.18 Bylaw Amendment CCSG Student Research Opportunities: This bylaw changes will create opportunities for Chaffey students to do compensated research on behalf of CCSG.
- g. Bill #3.2024.19 Bylaw Amendment CAT Funding & Support: This bill will permit CCSG to support and fund the Chaffey Activities Team. This funding may not exceed more than 10% of its budget to fund the Chaffey Activities Team.
- h. Bill #3.2024.20 Bylaw Amendment Non-student led Program Support and Funding: This bylaw changes will allow for CCSG to fund up to 10 non-student led Chaffey programs up to \$1500 per semester.

- a. Not to exceed \$1,000.00: Club transfer to the Evolve Club for funding request.
- b. Not to exceed \$800.00: Club transfer to the Psi Beta Psych Club for funding request.

Bill # 3.2024.5 Bylaw Amendment CCSG Operational Fund: To create an operational budget not to exceed \$50,000.00 to allow the Dean of Student Affairs to purchase training, unexpected time-sensitive expenses, CCSG personal development funds, and operational expenses with consultation with the executive board.
