COUNSELING

The counseling program provides qualified historically underrepresented students with "over and above" support to help them reach their educational goals. Services include priority registration, support with course material costs and educational supplies.



CARE

The Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education (CARE) program provides extra academic support to meet the unique needs of single parents.



EOPS Summer Readiness

The EOPS Summer Readiness Program (EOPS SRP) provides counseling services and program-specific specialized support to EOPS-eligible recent high school graduates committed to enrolling in summer courses (at minimum 2 classes.)



Undocumented Student Resource

The Undocumented Student Resource is dedicated to providing a safe space for undocumented students as they pursue their academic and professional goals.



NextUp/Scholars

The EOPS NextUp and Scholars programs are committed to providing a holistic supportive approach in counseling to our former foster youth population.

HOW DO YOU QUALIFY?

- Enroll in at least 12 units for Fall 2025
- Have less than 70 degree-applicable units completed (students who have completed an Associate's Degree or Bachelor's Degree are not eligible for the program.)
- · Transcripts from other schools must be submitted to the Chaffey College Admissions & Records office as soon as possible.
- Meet financial aid and other academic requirement

HOW DO YOU APPLY?

Apply online via the MyChaffey student portal in Self-Service (Registration) and select Additional Pages and Forms for Students.
