They will also receive a glimpse of what college is like by participating in an instructional cohort, engaging in motivational workshops, and utilizing campus resources. By the end of the summer, students will gain strategies for successfully navigating college, confidence in their ability to pursue higher education, and a strong sense of campus belonging.
